Thanks for your email to the Department of Transport and Main roads regarding improvements for cyclist crossing at Dandenong Road near Centenary Highway on and off ramp.

In regards to the planning, the Department of Transport and Main Roads has no current approved planning. Department is currently seeking funding to review the corridor to address safety and efficiency of the network which will include this section of road as well. However, funding for any future corridor planning review has to compete with state wide priorities.

In regards to address short term safety improvements for cyclist, I have requested operations team to investigate the issues you have raised as a holistic approach. The investigation will take 4-6 weeks to finalise due to other commitments and priorities. Once completed, department will contact you with the outcomes.
